

Cloth Napkins

In order to cut down on trash and save a little money in the meantime, I have created the tutorial to make cloth napkins. Make them in all different colors and patterns to go with everyday or a special occasion.

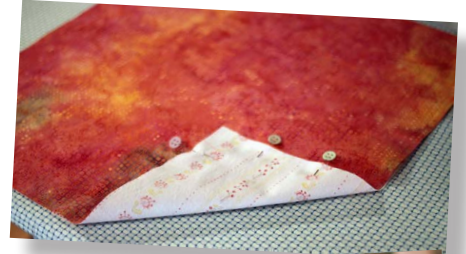
Approximate Finished Dimensions: 15 1/2" square

Supplies:

- Cotton fabric of your choice

- 1 • Cut 2 pieces of cotton fabric 16" square.
- 2 • With right sides together, stitch around the edges, leaving an opening big enough to get your hand through.
- 3 • Clip the corners
- 4 • Reach in to the opening and turn your napkin right side out. Taking time to go in to each corner and push the fabric out. Use a shopstick or some other bluntly pointed instrument, being careful not to push too hard and tear the fabric or stitching.
- 5 • Press the side seams flat. Take care with the opening pressing the sides evenly then pinning the opening closed.
- 6 • Stitch around the edges of the napkin staying as close to the edge as you feel comfortable.
- 7 • Make lots more!

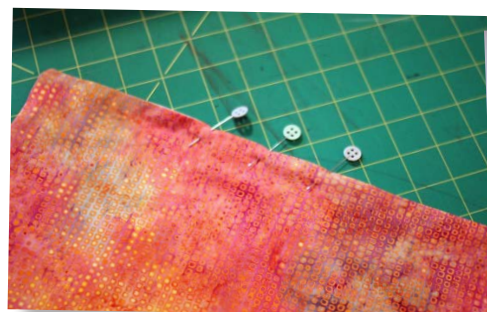

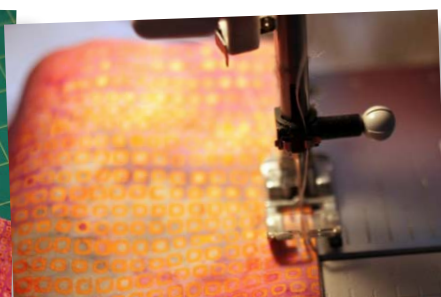
